



LOG INTO SAVONIA MOODLE WITH MANUAL ACCOUNT

If you don't have Savonia IDs and your school or workplace is not part of the HAKA federation (<https://wiki.eduuni.fi/pages/viewpage.action?pageId=27297776>), we can create your user name and password manually.

This is how you log in to Savonia Moodle with manually created account:

1. Go to <https://moodle.savonia.fi>
2. You can change the language in the lower right corner, picture below.
3. Type in your user name and your password into the corresponding boxes (surrounded with blue in the picture below) and click **Log in**.

CONTRACT FOR USING eLEARNING MATERIAL [\(Suomi\)](#) / [\(English\)](#)

Please read carefully the following terms and regulations before taking part in a course utilising eLearning material and/or methods. These terms concern student's rights to use eLearning material the educational establishment provides and educational establishment's rights to use eLearning material provided by the student. As the student registers for a course in which eLearning material and/or method is being used, the student is obliged to follow these terms in all teaching and eLearning material provided by the school. The concept eLearning means here all computer-aided teaching, including computer-aided contact lessons as well as distant learning.

1. Student's rights to use the teaching material

1.1 Limitations of use

- right to provide material for students who participate in the course in another manner in order to complete the tasks of the course (eg group assignments)

Teaching material is not allowed to be utilised in any other situation except with the eLearning subject/course in question without written authorisation of the provider. Copies provided on the basis of this contract may not be used, distributed, presented or showed in public or otherwise provide accessible to public in any other situation except in eLearning purposes. The right to use the material stipulated in this contract is not transferable to another person.

1.2 Moral rights

The student must refer to the writer of the material as well as other related persons/institutions in accordance with the legal and right manner. Any reference or mark to copyright must not be erased/deleted.
