- U Start of the project: 2002
- Basic ideas:
 - u revive Vydrovo valley
 - uinform on the forestry profession
 - udevelopment of conditions for small entrepreneurs for sale of goods and services
 - usupport of local traditions and alternative forms of culture
 - ubuild the station of Čiernohronská railway, stage for cultural events, shelters, fire-places, information boards, buffet with local specialties, water supply system, playground, providing guides on educational path

U Cooperation: unique co-operation between 4 different entities in building and maintaining joined investment Forests of SR s.e. Forest narrow village Čierny Balog VYDRA ngo gauge railway

- Financial investments:
 several millions SKK (mostly Forests of SR regional enterprise Čierny Balog)

21 ths. visitors during first year (2003) more than 24 ths. in 2005
