

Teacher and Non-teaching staff exchanges

Teachers can give lectures within the LLP/Erasmus partner schools around Europe. There has to be at least 5 hours of lectures per week. Non-teaching staff can specialize in learning from their colleagues and benchmarking. The time for one week exchange includes the normal working hours. The application period for teachers and non-teaching staff exchanges is annually until to the end of September.

In addition to the lectures the teacher also acts as a representative of the international relations and if necessary, checks the housing and course situation in the partner university. The same responsibilities can be addressed also to non-teaching staff. The teachers and other staff can apply for a grant for their exchange by filling in a teacher/staff mobility grant application.

Teacher and non-teaching staff exchanges concerning different projects will be informed separately. Within East-East Asia Network project there are two teacher exchange of two weeks annually.
